Player Expectations

- Represent IMPACT club in a way that brings respect and dignity to the name
- Be loyal to your teammates and coaches
- Coaches will be treated with respect and dignity
- The use of bad language will not be tolerated
- Any issues within the team should be handled with the head coach.

Practice Expectations

- Come prepared.
- Be on time
- Discussions on the court will be centered around volleyball.
- Persevere through difficult practices.
- Lean on your teammates for help.
- No phone usage during practices.
- Focus on practice by correcting habits.
- Always outwork the floor.
- Focus, Control, and Intensity will win games.
- Absences need to be communicated to coaches in advance.

Tournament Expectations

- Players will be at the designated meeting place with equipment on, jewelry off, and ready to play at the time coach communicates.
- If a player is late or missing equipment, consequences will be at the coach's discretion.
- Players will remain at the tournament until the team has finished its duties. This includes staying until referee and scorebook responsibilities are complete.

Tournament Expectations

- Playing time is a coach's decision. A minimum of 2 sets (if 1 day tournament) or 3 sets (if 2 day tournament) playing time can be expected. If concerns arise, the player and/or parents must attempt to handle the issue with the head coach.
 - A meeting can be scheduled for before or after practice time.
 - Conversations during a tournament are **not acceptable**.
 - If further discussion is needed, the director may be called to a joint meeting with the coaching staff, player, and parents.
